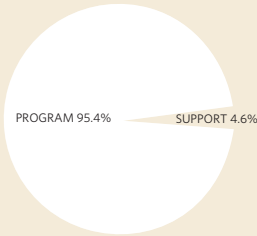

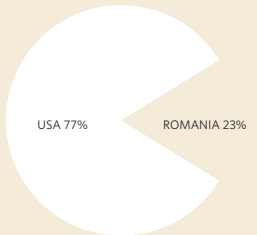

JOBS PROGRAM

Young people from Amy’s House, Pecica Campus, and Love Houses are learning the dignity & joy of work in the Jobs Program.

In 2022 the Jobs Program produced and sold over 26,000 packages of toilet paper and paper towels! There were six varieties of jams produced after gleaning the fruit from local orchards, and the RCE Thrift Store continued to offer bargain purchases for the community.

LOVING OUR UKRAINIAN NEIGHBORS

RCE hosted over 50 Ukrainian refugees in Arad during the year, providing housing, food, and supplies. Eight families (13 children) remain and RCE continues to help make life as “normal” as possible for them. RCE also continues to send needed supplies to the border of Ukraine.

After placing a child from Darius House into a Love House family, RCE provides financial & counseling support to Love House families as long as needed.

Only months after adopting Cosmina who has profound mental and psychological impairment since birth, the Vesa family took another very needy girl- Carina. Carina’s mind and body had been damaged due to horrific beating by her drunken biological father.

Over the years the girls have been loved and cared for by their extraordinary Love House mother, Florentina who never gives up on them no matter how challenging. Year-after-year when you ask her why, she always says the same thing. “I love them. They are my girls.” Like the Vesa family, God’s love flows through all the Love House families.

POVERTY PREVENTION

Ovi & Doina Martin, Lorena Soimosan and Vasile Boar bring help to families in need with vulnerable children preventing additional abandonment and suffering.

RCE served 270 families in 2023 with gifts of farm animals, firewood, and other support including 250 students received school supplies, 25 disabled persons received diapers, and over 400 food packages were delivered. Due to high building supply costs most building projects were smaller, such as helping a family repair their roof, or replace windows.

Tragically the Vesa family house, animal shed, and garage burned down last winter. RCE stepped in with two teams from America and support from partners to help them rebuild. The foundation, walls and roof are complete with interior work to be completed in 2023.
